Lieut. Slatte reported to duty in the  
Trenches Lines, just after the Company had  
moved forward and taken up its position in  
BLOCK 7 ENCH. near CHS 1851, on August 30th  
1914. The Company was in close support to the  
forward Brigade which had been recently attacked.  
Lieut. Slatte volunteered to go forward and  
reinforce the front line situation. Although  
the action was under a heavy fire on every  
side and a gun, he visited all the  
forward Battalion and handed in an invaluable  
report regarding their dispositions. Some time  
later, this Company was shelled very heavily,  
and during the two hours it lasted, Lieut.  
Slatte showed a very fine example to the men  
by moving about and caring for the wounded, both  
on our side and of the forward Brigade, being all  
the time exposed to the heaviest shellfire.  
After being wounded, he still continued  
attending the wounded, until he was again hit,  
and he had to go out of the line.  
Lieut. Slatte's untiring work and the  
splendid example of gallantry he set most fully

On the morning of August 31st, the 21st Brigade on the right flank, attacked, and the enemy placed a heavy barrage on BRIGADE Trench, near THE LASSY, which was occupied by Pte Wilson's Company. During the two hours of the bombardment, he displayed a fine courage, in attending to wounded, both our own and of the attacking Brigade while exposed to the most heavy fire from a rifle and a gun, and he undoubtedly helped to save many lives.

In the attack of Sept. 1st 1918 on the WEST AND CHATEAU TRENCH, near HENDRECHOU, he took charge of the Lewis Gun section, when the gun was wounded and led it through a heavy rifle and a rifle fire to the objective. After consolidating the position, he proceeded to salvage ammunition in the Lewis Gun. The village of HENDRECHOU had not then been cleared, and he continued his work under a hail of rifle fire, showing an utter disregard to his personal safety. His coolness and steadiness throughout the day was an example to all units.

When the Battalion was holding the line on August 31st 1918, near HENDICOTT the Coy in which Pte Still was acting as Stretcher Bearer was occupying a trench. The enemy put down a heavy barrage on the trench, causing many casualties. Pte Still heard someone calling for help, climbed out of the trench immediately and went forward and secured a wounded Officer. Subsequently, Pte Still continued to bring in wounded throughout the day though he became exhausted. He was slightly wounded himself but refused to go out. All ranks who witnessed his performance were emphatic in stating that it was one of the most brilliant examples of personal bravery that one could wish to see. His gallantry was, without question, of the very highest and most exceptional character.



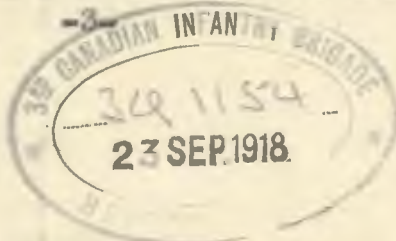

With four men he fought his way out to a flank and finally with great gallantry, rushed two posts and disposed of the garrison.
